## Read the following passage and answer questions 39-50

The police keep us safe on the streets and in our homes. They are trained to prevent people from breaking the laws and to arrest those who do so. Police officers also control crowds, direct traffic and give first aid to victims of accidents. They are expected to be ready to assist anyone in need of help.

Their motto, "Utumishi kwa wote" is meant to show that they serve all.

There are both male and female police officers. They work together under the same working conditions. Most police officers wear uniform while at work.

Patrolling is one of the duties of the police. They may patrol on foot, horse back, bicycles or motocycles, in motor cars even in aeroplanes and helicopters.

In addition to the normal work the police may have to do special duties. For example, police my on patrol may have to look after lost children or stray dogs. Police officers with trained dogs my be set to control disorderly crowds or track criminals or prisoners who have run away. Police dogs are also used to search for hidden drugs.

Some police officers are given traffic control duties. They make sure that drivers do not exceed the specified speed limits and that they obey the traffic laws. They check to see that the vehicles are properly

licenced and insured and that they are roadworthy. The traffic police also direct traffic at cross road. Police orricers in boats help rescue people from drowning. The police also patrol national borders. When a crime has been committed the police carry out investigations. This is usually done by officers from Criminal Investigations Departments (C.I.D) who are attached to most large police stations. There are also police department which try to prevent the buying and selling illegal drugs.
