- iii) He mixed and ate with tax collectors known to be sinners. He divorced Levi and went to his house.

- iv) He broke the law of the Sabbath day / His disciples broke the Sabbath day law by plucking corn on the bath / He healed the man with a paralyzed hand on a Sabbath day
- v) The question of fasting; the Pharisees were annoyed that this disciples did not fast
- vi) He made it clear that he had not comment to call the righteous but the sinners; they accused of mixing with sinners when He called Levi
- vii) He challenged them to change from the old traditional order to the new one He had brought; they accused Him of washing hands before eating
