By the time my father left for Nairobi, I was attending Nakeel school. I was in standard eight in the same class with Kilunda my step brother. Kilunda was such a naughty and proud boy. He had been pampered. He liked using abusive language and he always provoked others to fighting even at school. Because of that behaviour, he was constantly punished by teachers. Sometimes they made him water the newly planted plants. Other times he would be ordered to run around the play ground while mooing, to indicate that he was as stupid as a cow. There were other times Kilunda absented himself from school. He would spend the day gambling with some boys who didn't go to school.

Kilunda was a very stupid boy in class. He usually scored zero mark in Mathematics. In terminal tests, he was always the last. One of his worst subjects was English. But he was the best pupil in sports. In running competitions, he would sprint like an antelope, leaving the whole school behind him. He ran in a very funny way, holding up like a lump and rolling very fast.

I think his mother hated me because I was a better pupil in class. In my class I was always between number three and five. Kilunda started hating me just as much as his mother did. He always obtained pleasure from insulting me and beating me on our way to school. There were times, too, when he would throw soil into my eyes and call me a mongoose. He would beat me up and warn me. "You little mongoose, dare you go and report this to the teacher then I'll kill you on our way home.!".

One day Kilunda deliberately stepped on a wounded toe I was nursing. I hurt the toe while running in the field, looking after the livestock. God, I had never experienced such pain. In the evening, I reported him to his mother. When she asked him whether that was true, Kilunda cracked. "That is a pure lie by this thing people call Mwende." Read the passage below and answer questions 39 - 50

Knowledge is power. One of the best ways of acquiring knowledge is reading. The more one reads the more knowledge one gains. Some people say that a person who can read has armed himself or herself with a shield against stupidity.

It is important for children to develop an interest in reading early in life. This is because reading is a lifelong activity, there simply is no end to it. Knowledge is being created everyday at an incredible speed.

At such, there is no point at which any one person can claim to have read all that there is to read. Apart from reading, for academic purposes as learners in school we also need to read for other purposes such as self-improvement and enjoyment. We may read about how to improve our relationships with the people around us. We may also read humorous stories as a way of relaxation. It is through reading that children learn basic things about life such as eating a balanced diet, morality and religious facts. Thus, there is a lot to be gained from books even when we are not reading for an examination. Reading also helps us to express ourselves and communicate well with other people.

It is often said that Kenyans do not read as much as they should. They are known to be aggressive on other field of life such as athletics and business. But how successful would an athlete be if he or she did not bother to read about strategies that can help him or her to excel in athletics? What businesss person would not want to read business articles that will help him or her to market his or her goods to achieve better results?

The truth is that to excel at what we are doing we must be inquisitive so that we can learn how to improve. In short, when we read we increase the likelihood of coming across information that will be useful to us. That information would be hidden from us completely if we did not know how to read.

Everybody should be involved in promoting the development of a reading culture in our country. The challenge, therefore, not only goes to teachers but also to parents, readers, and other members of the society.

They should ensure that children are exposed to different types of reading materials. These include simple textbooks, storybooks, magazines and newspapers. Pupils have responsibility to take an active role in becoming good leaders. They should take up every opportunity to read whatever useful material is available for them. They should also read widely and not restrict themselves to one type of reading material such as storybooks.






