Moving to a new place can be an exciting experience. In a new environment, you somehow feel more alive: seeing new people, eating new food, hearing the foreign sounds of a new language and feeling a different climate. As the days pass however, this good feeling becomes difficult and stressful. The new experiences turn to be boring rather enjoyable.

In the first stage, you are excited by your new environment. You experience some simple difficulties such as trying to socialize but you consider these as small challenges that you can quickly overcome. Your feelings about the new culture are positive, so you are eager to make contact with people and to try new food. Soon, the difference in behavior and customs become more noticeable to you. This may make it difficult for you to find new friends since you don't know the social customs of the new culture. For instance, you may not understand how to make "small talk" so it is hard to carry out a <u>casual</u> conversation

One day in the school, you overhear a conversation and you understand the meaning. Why is everyone laughing? Are they laughing at you or at some jokes that you do not understand? Also you aren't always sure how to act while shopping. If you buy a sweater in the wrong size, can you exchange it?

Within no time, you will realize that you no longer have positive feelings about the new place. You feel that you or your parents made a mistake in going there, making of friends hasn't been easy so you begin to feel lonely and isolated. Now you want to be with familiar people and eat familiar food. You begin to have negative feelings about everything and you want to go back home.

Gradually, as your language skills of the area improves, you begin to have some success in meeting people. You are now able to exchange the sweater that was too small and you can successfully chat about the weather with a stranger on a bus. Your self confidence grows. After realizing that you cannot change your surroundings, you begin to accept the difference and tolerate them. For example, the food will never be as tasty as that in your home area but you are now able to eat and sometimes eve enjoy many dishes. You may equally not like the way some people there dress or behave in public but you do not regard their clothes and behaviour as wrong but just different


















