



A man was yesterday shot dead and a police officer injured, as more than 100 houses were burnt down during the eviction of <u>squatters</u> from a farm in Uasin Gishu County. Police officers in riot gear were sent to remove the 74 families comprising 800 people, following a High Court ruling. They burnt down the houses at the <u>controversial</u> Ben Moi Farm.

Justice Oteng'o Ombwayo of the Environment and Lands Court in Eldoret, dismissed a petition by squatters against two companies claiming ownership of the 3,000 acres in Moiben constituency. The squatters' appeal was dismissed.

Eldoret East Police boss Nelson Taliti, who led the operation, confirmed that one of his officers was shot in the leg by the squatters.

"We came here to evict the squatters and they resisted and shot one of our officers. We then retaliated and shot one person dead," said Mr. Taliti.

"We are searching for an AK 47 that was used to shoot the officer and we will not rest until we find it," he said.




