





Kila safari kutoka Nakuru hadi Eldoret na kurudi ni safari ndefu, ililazimu dereva kuendesha gari hilo kwa kasi sana ili kutimiza matakwa ya mwajiri wao.

Siku moja dereva huyo alipokuwa amekaribia kufika Timboroa huku akiendesha gari hilo kwa kasi, alikutana na lori la kubeba mchanga. Kufumba na kufumbua, wakagongana dafrao kichwa kwa kichwa. Gari hilo la abiria liliharibika vibaya sana na likapondekapondeka. Abiria watatu walikufa papo hapo na wengine

wengi wakajeruhiwa vibaya sana na kupelekwa hospitalini wakiwa mahututi. Dereva na kondakta wake walinusurika kwa kupata majeraha madogo madogo.




