

2.0 INFORMATION ON THE YEAR 2018 KCSE EXAMINATION

2.1 CANDIDATURE

During the year *2018 KCSE examination*, there were *660,204 candidates* who sat for the examination compared to *611,952 candidates* in the year *2017*. This represents an increase of *48,252 candidates*, or a *7.88% increase*. The examination was taken in *10,078 examination centres* across the country, compared to *9,701 examination centres* in the year *2017*. This represents an increase of *547 examination centres*.

A breakdown of the candidature and examination centres for the year *2018 KCSE examination* is shown in **Tables 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7 & 8** and **Graphs 1**.

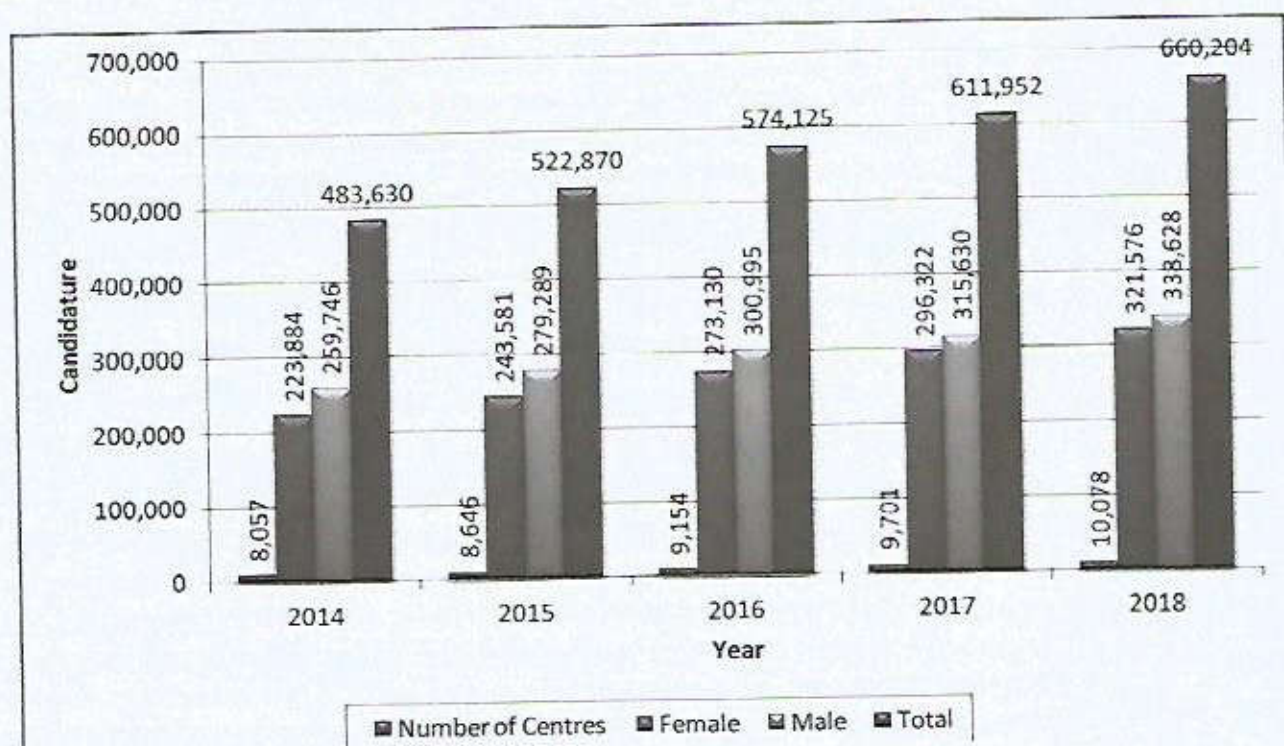


Figure 1: KCSE Examination Candidature Trends for the Last 5 Years
