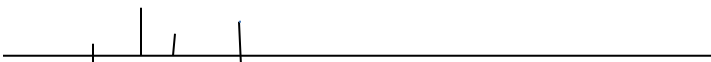

a) How many cartons were there (2mks)

b) What was the total mass of the empty cartons. (2mks)

1284 x 2568kg

c) What was the total mass of books alone? (2mks)
